PROGRAMMING:

THE IMPORTANCE OF PLAY

Here we are nearing Easter and the end of Term I. All of our children returning from last year have settled into Preschool and have been excited about graduating to the Rainbow Room. Our new little ones are making new friends and learning all the fun things that happen at Preschool, while they play. Through play children develop a sense of social dynamics and an understanding of what is, or is not appropriate behaviour in a given setting. Through interactions they learn a good deal, including social skills and values, and the ability to form relationships while refining their understanding of their experiences in the world through play.

With this in mind play becomes a key measure through which the children's understanding can be observed by the teachers' and appropriate learning areas can be set up to challenge and develop this learning.
